### *Supplies:*

You can use any cotton yarn from your stash with suitable hook size

I used cotton yarn and hook size 2,5 mm

Fiberfill

Scissors and needle

### *Abbreviations (US)*

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

dec = decrease

inc = increase

BLO = back loop only

FLO = front loop only

Sl st = slip stitch

St = stitch

Dc = double crochet

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## *Pattern*

### *Bottom part*

R1: with skin color; 6sc in magic ring (6)  
R2: inc 6 x (12)  
R3: (inc, sc) repeat (18)  
R4: (1sc, inc, 1sc) repeat (24)  
R5: (inc, 3sc) repeat (30)  
R6: (2sc, inc, sc4) repeat, end with 2sc (36)  
R7: (inc, 5sc) repeat (42)  
R8: (3sc, inc, 6sc) repeat, end with 3sc (48)  
R9: (inc, 7sc) repeat (54)  
R10: BLO, 54sc (54)  
R11: (7sc, dec) repeat (48)  
R12 and R13: 48sc (48)  
R14: (7sc, inc) repeat (54)  
R15 – R19: 54sc (54) Fasten off yarn

### *Top part*

R1: with black; 6sc in magic ring (6)  
R2: inc 6 x (12)  
R3: (inc, sc) repeat (18)  
R4: (1sc, inc, 2sc) repeat, end with 1sc (24)  
R5: (inc, 3sc) repeat (30)  
R6: (2sc, inc, sc4) repeat, end with 2sc (36)  
R7: 36sc (36)  
R8: (inc, 5sc) repeat (42)  
R9: (3sc, inc, 6sc) repeat, end with 3sc (48)  
R10 and R11: 48sc (48)  
R12: (7sc, inc) repeat (54)  
R13 and R14: 54sc (54)  
R15: FLO; ch3, 3dc, skip next st, sl st in next st, (4dc, skip next st, sl st in next st) repeat (-) till end, fasten off.

To reinforce the top part, I made a second black part:

Crochet R 1 – R9 from top part again, fasten off and attach to the inside of the top part.

Cut a circle out of a cardboard piece and place on bottom (to stabilize).

Embroider eyes and eyebrows with black yarn and mouth with red yarn before you sew bottom and top together.

Sew top and bottom together and stuff firmly before you close.

Sew or glue roses on the head.

Rose:

Ch30, start in 2<sup>nd</sup> from the hook, (2dc, sl st in next st, ch3) repeat till end, fasten off and fold into rose shape.

I also made roses with a thicker sparkling yarn and made a 20chain for those.

For the roses on the sides of the head I also made a 20chain.

Put the pins in and ready!

Use your creativity to decorate your pincushion as you like!
